The Project

Duration: Nov. 2020 - Oct. 2022 (24 months)

Objectives: to innovate VET provision through an intense capacity building action

- To create opportunities for VET organisations to exchange practices and discuss about innovation on regular basis
- To improve competences on teaching methodologies and raise awareness on three VET dimensions considered some of the main drivers of innovation: Entrepreneurship education, Social Inclusion, Technology enabled learning.
- To develop synergies among VET organisations in Europe to develop innovation in these three dimensions of VET
